Our Cadets are older children from the age of 11 to 18. Just like the Badgers, our Cadets enjoy a wide subject area but also take, and renew, their first aid certificate on a regular basis. The youngsters complete their First Aid Plus certificate and their Essential Care certificate from the age of 13 after which they can go along and offer first aid cover at public duties. They are always closely supervised and it's a great way for them to gain experience and skills.

The Cadets all get the chance to participate in our Grand Prior Scheme under which they work towards the successful completion of a variety of subjects and gain certificates and badges along the way.
