	Spread the word about your amazing fundraising event on social media. Share a link to

	event updates, and make sure you tweet <u>@stjohnambulance</u> and like us on <u>Facebook</u> .

Week 10	Enjoy your event! Have fun baking cakes, singing karaoke, or whatever it is you're

	Remember to thank everyone on the day. Keep money safe and secure and ensure you
	clear away everything after your event.
